Registration and Fee Policy

To facilitate the registration and administration of the various camps, the following policy will be adhered to. Please note: When filling out registration forms, please do the following:

- Circle which camp (camp name, Jr., Sr. High, etc...
 - Complete Camper Information Form
- Complete front side of the Camper Health History Record
- Make checks payable to "Community of Christ", Campground name (Manitou etc.) and Name of Camp. (Early Jr. etc.)

• FULL PAYMENT DUE BEFORE CAMP BEGINS

Late Arrivals: It shall be the responsibility of the camper and the camper's parent or guardian to make prior arrangements before the beginning of camp to admit the camper as a late arrival. This can be done by e-mail or by telephone with the camp director. This guarantees a reservation. There shall be no reduction in fees for campers who arrive late.

Absenteeism: Some campers have desired to attend camp and to work a job, participate in school athletics or to take academic courses such as summer school or driver's education.

The camper needs to contact the camp director **BEFORE** camp with their situation. The director has the prerogative to approve or not approve part time attendance at camp.

In accordance with state law, the Registration Form and the Health History Record must either accompany the camper to the camp or must be provided with pre-registration. Campers who do not have this documentation cannot be allowed to stay for the camping experience. **PLEASE** be sure that all health information is complete. All information is required by the State of Michigan to be on file during camp.
