What the Mission Center Does for You - Part 6

Mission centers are charged to provide financial resource development and support to congregations.

Each congregation has a Financial Officer (CFO) who has significant responsibilities within the congregation regarding much more than just money management. The Mission Center provides training, support and oversight for the individuals that serve in these vital ministry roles for their congregations. The Mission Center also supports congregation's leaders as they work through requirements for building projects, obtaining loans for necessary repairs, insurance claims, oblation assistance, and congregational budget development.

The Mission Center's operating budget is approved annually at a Mission Center Conference. Staff input regarding ministry and programming desires for the coming year is gathered and then shared with the Mission Center Finance Committee which consists of eight members from various congregations across the Mission Center. The Finance Committee prepares preliminary sample budgets for congregations and individuals to consider when deciding their generous response through congregational support. The preliminary sample budgets are shared at several gatherings across the Mission Center to gather input from the membership at large. Congregational responses regarding financial support for the coming year is collected and a revised final budget is then prepared by the Finance Committee for consideration at the Mission Center Conference. The generosity-based budgeting approach that allows congregations to choose their level of financial support for the ministries of the Mission Center has worked well thanks to the generosity of congregations and individuals through offering envelope contributions.

Another source of income for the Mission Center's annual operating budget comes from investment support. Thanks to the wise planning of the former jurisdictions that now make up the Michigan Mission Center, the Mission Center has reserve funds available that provide investment income that The

Mission Center Council, in conjunction with the Finance Committee, approved the Fiscal & Investment Policy that guides the decisions regarding the use of those reserve funds for supporting ministries. The Mission Center also holds many Restricted/Designated Funds for purposes such as camps, reunions, youth activities, etc. due to the generosity of many throughout the years. One such example is the Youth Camp Scholarship Fund that provided scholarships to 79 youth last summer who may not have been able to attend otherwise helps support ministries in the budget.

The Finance Committee welcomes suggestions for new and continued ministries that the membership feels will help us do together "what matters most for the journey ahead" which is MISSION of course!
